

## CV

Mirco Marchelli (b. 1963, Novi Ligure, Italy) a multidisciplinary artist whose practice seamlessly intertwines visual art, music, and memory. Originally trained as a musician, his work has evolved into a distinctive artistic language that fuses found objects, books, textiles, and furniture, all preserved in wax to create deeply evocative compositions. His use of muted palettes, layered textures, and abstract harmonies lends his pieces an almost archaeological quality, inviting the viewer into a world of nostalgia and poetic transformation.

Drawing inspiration from Dadaism and Arte Povera, Marchelli embraces an ethos of reinvention and preservation, where forgotten materials are given new life. His approach to composition mirrors musical structures, with rhythm, repetition, and tonal balance guiding the arrangement of his works.

Since the 1990s, Marchelli has exhibited widely across Europe, showcasing his work in major museums and galleriessuch as Palazzo Fortuny (Venice), the Juan March Museum (Palma de Mallorca), and Ingleby Gallery (Edinburgh). His pieces are housed in renowned public and private collections, including the Lercaro Foundation (Bologna) and Fundació Vila Casas (Barcelona).

Marchelli continues to explore the intersection of art, sound, and material transformation from his studio in Ovada, Italy, where he refines his singular approach to contemporary assemblage.
